Further to this premium lounge, all First Class and Business Class international guests travelling with Oman Air to Muscat International airport are invited to enjoy the impressive arrival lounge. Nature has been the inspiration behind this lounge and the elegant and tranquil surroundings offer semi-public spaces with plenty of light. The service area is located at the upper corner in order to leave a large communal space for guests to enjoy.

The area of the arrival lounge located in the mezzanine floor in the arrival side of the airport is 237 square metres and has 90 seats.
